Healthcare Settings

Day 1

- Principles/Guidelines for Environmental cleaning/ Disinfection in Healthcare Settings (Nursing Home and Centre-Based)
- Procedures for Cleaning and Disinfection in Healthcare Settings and Patient's home when nursing care is done at home, which should include at least the following:
 - Frequency of routine cleaning and maintenance for various surfaces, facilities, equipment, items, etc
 - Surfaces eg Floors, Table tops, Carpets, etc
 - * Facilities eg toilets, kitchen, rehab, isolation room (terminal cleaning), etc
 - Types of cleaning/disinfecting agents and the dilution guide.

Learner should know the principles and apply to the situations when required.

- Equipment/items, eg stepper, grab bars, walking frames, linens, etc
- Summative review for the day's learning

Day 2

- Comply with WSH and infection control policy and procedures
- Management and proper disposal for at least the following :
 - * General Wastes
 - * Biohazard Wastes
 - * Blood and Body Fluids
 - * Spillages
- Proper storage and maintenance of cleaning/disinfecting equipment/agents
- Roles & Responsibilities (e.g. performing audit, assessing competency, etc.)
 - * Supervisors, Staff
