OVERVIEW



This course is designed for healthcare professionals who have little or no knowledge of Hokkien to communicate with patients and their relatives. The focus is on speaking and listening where accuracy and fluency will be stressed. Participants will also have an insight into Chinese culture, which is embedded within the language contexts.
