Mental Health First Aid for Older Persons (MHFA-OP) aims to teach participants to recognise common mental health problems in older persons such as depression, dementia, anxiety, psychosis and confusion. Participants are guided through the basic first aid steps to support the older person in a mental health crisis until the person is referred for professional help. MHFA-OP trains participants to recognise mental health problems, provide initial help, and guide the affected person towards appropriate professional help.

LEARNING OBJECTIVE

Upon completion of this programme, participants will be able to:

- Know what constitutes mental health issues
- Recognise and provide initial help to older persons with common mental health problems such as depression, dementia, anxiety and psychosis.
- Learn the basic first aid steps that are used to support the older person in mental health crisis until the person is referred for professional help.
